Dear Parents/Guardians:

With the winter weather upon us it is very important that you have a “plan of action” in place with your child if we should have an early dismissal because of weather. If the forecast is ominous, your child should be aware of what to do BEFORE leaving for school in the morning.

Student drop off each morning begins at 7:15 when our doors open for student arrival. With the cooler weather starting please be sure students are dressed for the cold. If they arrive at school before 7:15, they will be waiting outside. All students should be in their classrooms when the tardy bell rings at 7:50.

The office is extremely busy during early dismissal and because of this, the phone may not be available for students to let parents know that we are dismissing early. Be sure to listen to the radio or watch the TV for the possibility of an early dismissal.

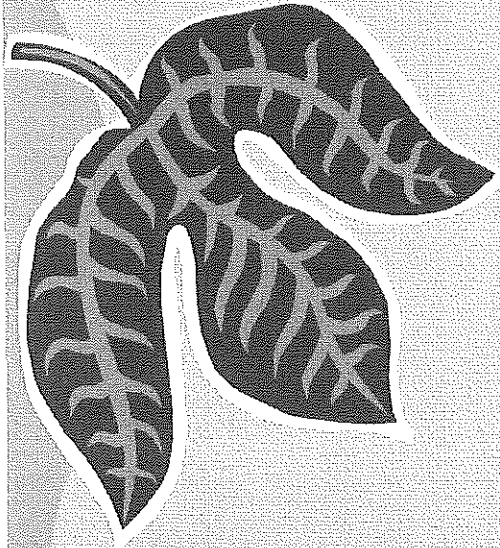
The Oxford School Department announces the cancellation of school, a two hour delay, or an early dismissal on radio station WSRS (96.1 FM) and television channels 4, 5, 6, 7, and NECN. Parents should also receive an auto-alert phone call as long as you have updated your phone number in PowerSchool. You may also check the school department website, www.oxps.org to see dismissals, delays, or NO school announcements. Parents can also receive a text alert to your phone from the Superintendent’s office by registering on “Remind”. (Directions for this are on the district webpage, under Parent Links, Text Alerts.)

If we have a two-hour delay students should not arrive at school BEFORE 9:15 AM. Bus transportation begins at 8:55 AM and school begins at 9:45 AM. Dismissal should be at the normal time of 2:15 PM.

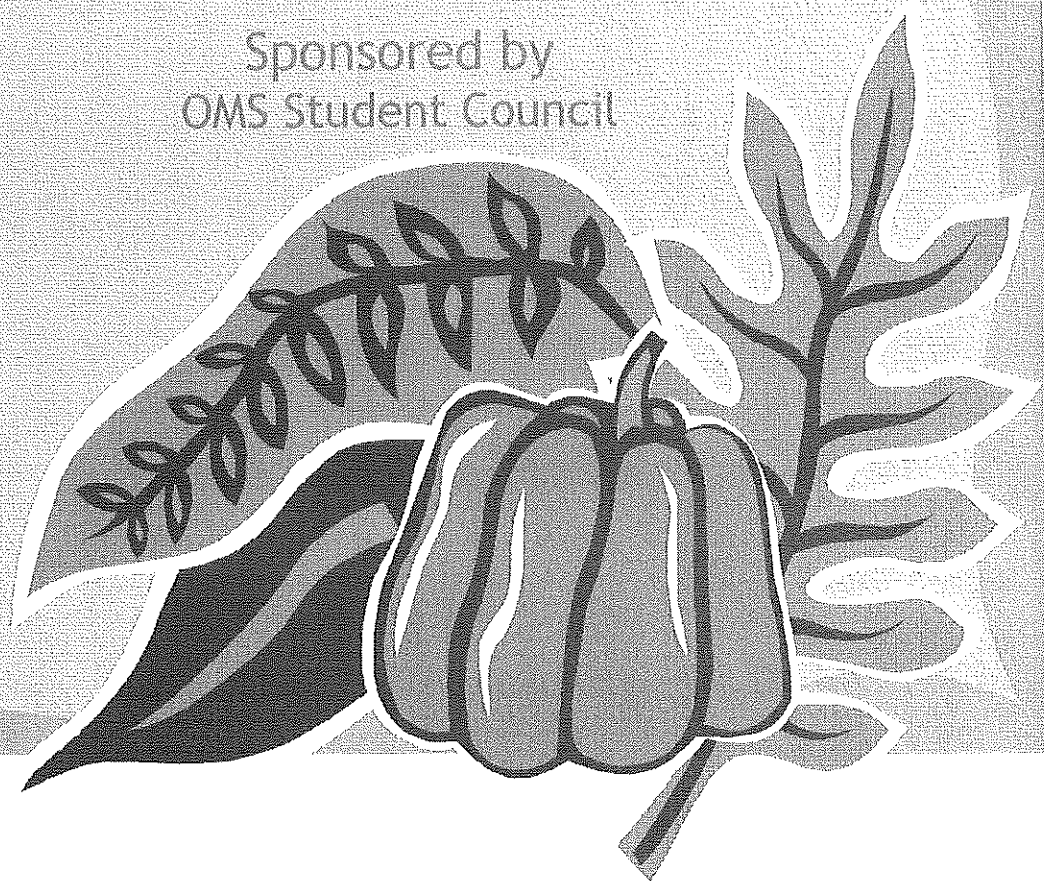
Food Drive
