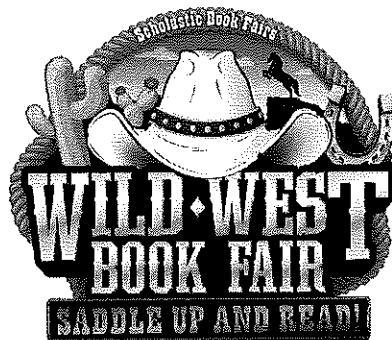

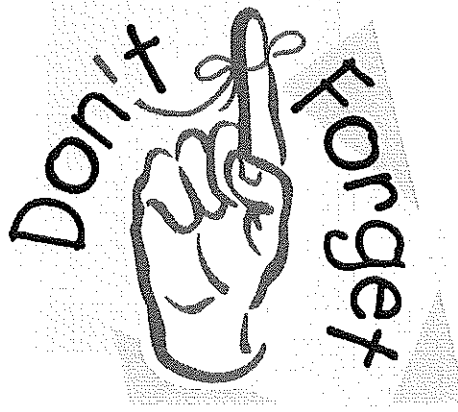

Attendance at both sessions is strongly recommended. Each player should arrive 30 minutes before the first tryout to complete registration. A mandatory parent meeting will be held after the teams are made, which will take place in the OHS café. All players must tryout at their current grade level (no playing up unless determined prior). All registration forms are on the back of the brochure and should be brought to tryouts.

## Costs

- \*Registration fee - \$175.00 per player (this includes costs for referees, league fees, gym fees, insurance fees, custodial fees, and uniforms).
- \*Uniforms - All newly registered players will be responsible for a one-time fee of \$65.00 for a team uniform (a pair of shorts and a jersey), returning players who still have their uniforms will not need to pay this fee unless they elect otherwise for reasons such as; damage, loss, etc.
- \*All checks payable to Oxford Travel Basketball.
- \*There will be a \$35.00 discount for any additional child registered within a family.

## How much time is involved?

- \*Games will begin on November 26<sup>th</sup> and will continue to be played until the end of February. All games will be played on Sundays. Most will take place in the morning, while some might extend into the early afternoon. There will be two practices per week (on days to be determined) and the travel will stay within South Central Massachusetts.
